<p>Avoid sharing details of suicide method and location</p> <p>Research shows that public communication that includes descriptions of suicide method or location has been associated with increased rates of suicide behaviour and imitation of the suicide method/location.</p>	
PROBLEMATIC	PREFERRED
Detail about method or location of suicide Images that show method or location of a suicide	No details of method or location. If needed, use general terms instead of specific details. No photos, illustrations, diagrams or video that show suicide method or location.

Guidelines:

Do not use uppercase when submitting your abstracts. Sentence case only.

Do not submit the same abstract across multiple presentation types.

Symposium

Symposiums should include a chair and 5 presenters. The chair can be one of the presenters. Each presenter must include a financial disclosure.

Symposiums must be submitted by one person but include all abstract components and all financial disclosures.

Symposium abstract maximum word length is 2200 words. Symposiums components should include:

1. Overall Title
2. Overall Abstract/Concept (200 words)
3. 5 presentation Abstracts (400 words) each with 1 Learning Objective but no other format requirements

Symposium sessions will be 90 minutes in total, including Q&A

Workshop

Workshop abstracts maximum word length is 500 words. Workshop components should include:

1. Workshop Title
2. 3 learning Objectives
3. background
4. format/session plan
5. 2 facilitators

Workshop sessions will be 90 minutes in total, including Q&A

Oral

Oral abstract maximum word length is 400 words. Oral components should include:

1. Oral Presentation Title
2. 1 Learning Objective
3. Background
4. Methods
5. Result
6. Discussion

Oral presentations will be 10 minutes, with a collective Q&A session if time permits, after the final session speaker.

Poster

Poster abstract maximum word length is 400 words. Poster components should include:
